

Luttons Parish Council Minutes.

Meeting Held August 3rd.2010.

Present.--- Mrs.A. Corbett,Mrs. M. Weldon.Mr.A. Thornton,Mr.R. Eadie,Mr. A. Pickering,Mr.A. --- Crookes and Mrs. P Sherred. Apologies from Mr A. Keith.Eight Members of the public attended.

The Minutes of the A.G. M. were presented by the Clerk and passed after a complaint by Councillor Eadie that an addition to the Minutes provided by himself over the election of the Clerk had not been included. It was agreed that this would be added as an addendum to these Minutes together with the Chairmans response and provided for the Notice-Boards and the Web-site.

Finance.--The Clerk submitted the financial position of the year end,stating funds of £7,415.021,minus unrepresented cheques of £92,giving a net balance of £7,323.021 at the bank. The requirements of Mazars,our external auditors,had been complied with before the end of June and they had contacted me concerning three items concerning total funds held at the Bsnk, the minuting of the Audit and the requirement of a budget statement for funding held at the bank.

The following budget was agreed on at this meeting.

£1,000 annually for the upkeep of Helperthorpe and Luttons churchyards.

£1,000 in reserve for the Parish Council elections due in 2011 in case of any contest.

£1000 for payment for Parish Notice-boards.

£750 for the annual village Bonfire celebrations.

£ 1,000 for the Queens Diamond Jubilee celebrations ,including souvenir mugs for the children in the three villages.

The rest of Parish funds are to be reserved for unseen emergencies.

Correspondence. -- A letter from Mr. Wane of West Lutton of West Lutton had been sent by Recorded Delivery to the Chairman and every Parish Councillor and its contents were discussed.

It was decided to send a letter to Ryedale District Council expressing disapproval at the proposed sale of Wentworth Street car park in Malton.

Any Other Business.-- Questions were put by some Parish Councillors as to our current Insurance Policy.The Clerk was asked to check that our current Insurance cover was still sufficient for all concerned.

Mr. Armstrong of Esst Lutton kindly volunteered to rejuvenate the public benches in the Parish and our thanks are extended to him.
