Four members of the public attended the meeting.

Election of Officers. Chairman. Mrs A. Corbett.-Proposed Mr. A.Thornton.Seconded Mrs. P. Sherred.

Vice.Chairman. Mrs. P. Sherred.-Proposed mr. A. Pickering. Seconded Mr.A..Crookes.

Both were unanimously re-elected.

Minutes. -After welcoming the new Clerk,Mr. Dupontet, the Chairman,as acting Clerk from December -
----- 8th.2009 until April 2010, ,read the Minutes,unanimously approved

Finance. -- Updated financial details were provided,inclusive of the annual Precept allowance and all
----- bills paid to the end of April,2010,amounting to the sum of £1,355.77p.,inclusive of Mazars
annual auditing fee,grass cutting expenditure,payment for fireworks on November 5th 2009 and gifts to
the Parish Plan for dog-mess bins and Spring bulbs. .

Correspondence.--Letters written to the Highways Department, requesting :repairs to roads and paths in
-----Helpertorpe were read, also correspondence relating to the telephone kiosk there.The
kiosk cannot be bought for £1 and will remain intact, since Ryedale District Council decided it would
cost too much to remove the electronic equipment.

A letter from Mr. Crawford on behalf of Luttons Parish Church Council requested a
sum of £1,000 from the Parish Council to help fund repairs to St Marys churchyard wall estimated to
cost around £10,281,including V.A.T.This was agreed,subject to the work going ahead. It was
suggested that a mobile phone unit in the church tower could help,with a profit of £3,000 a year ,but
this was rejected,since it might not be acceptable to the church authorities.

Matters Arising.--Mr. R. Eadie suggested that five grass-cuts a year at a cost of £246 per cut should be
-----sufficient rather than seven.,He reported that he had found a company which could
supply the five new notice-boards for the villages and St.Marys church,West Lutton...He also said that
he did not know much about Parish Council rules and would like more information.

The four members of the public present suggested that Parish Council Minutes
could be put on Notice-Boards and the web-site and this will happen in future. An annual Parish
Meeting was also requested and a future Parish Council meeting ,will be given a special name for this
occasion. It was explained that in a small rural Parish like ours paying annual bills regularly and careful
spending meant that any local needs could be met when necessary.It was also explained that the
services of Mr. Winship regarding any legal advice were already well-known to Luttons Parish
Council..
