

LUTTONS AND HELPERTHORPE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING OCTOBER 26TH 2010 MINUTES

Apologies were received from councillors Eady Crookes Keith and Pratt present chair A. Corbett vice chair P. Sherrad M. Weldon A. Pickering A. Thornton .

The minutes from the meeting at August 3rd were read and approved and signed by the chair.

Councillor Thornton said his field was available for the annual bonfire and a bale of straw would be placed in it. Then the villagers could build a fire. He also stated he had tables for serving of food.

Councillor Sherrad suggested gazebos should be placed over the serving tables after much discussion it was decided that the bonfire would be moved to another day in the event of rain. Councillor Sherrad also volunteered to supply the onions left over from show for the bonfire food.

Councillor Pickering raised the question of Mr Carpenters drive way stating that the builders put a bucket of sand and gravel in the gypsy race causing the level to raise and cause flooding, Making the neighbours who use the stone bridge across gypsy race to turn in his drive a letter concerning both these matters to be sent to Councillors Haigh and Richard Mann. Councillor Pickering has dealt with the matter himself.

A Burkinshaw wants to extend the neighbour watch schemes to Luttons and Helperthorpe areas. Clerk will correspond it was also suggested that the warbler be contacted to run an article for volunteers for neighbourhood watch.

A lady in Helperthorpe watches the country file which featured a diseased horse chestnut tree it was suggested that the horse chestnut trees in Helperthorpe be checked by the Rydale tree surgeon and his comments noted.
