Digital Switchover of Yorkshire TV Region

Digital Switchover, for the **Yorkshire TV Region**, is upon us! The transmitter at Oliver's Mount, Scarborough, and the relay transmitter at Weaverthorpe, switch over to digital transmission only starting on 3rd August 2011, when the BBC2 analogue signal ceases, and completing on 17th August 2011, when all other analogue TV signals cease. So if you watch **Yorkshire TV** through an aerial you will need a digital receiver and to retune your digital equipment at each stage of the switchover. All Freeview, TopUpTV and BT Vision digital televisions, boxes and recorders will need to be retuned. Switchover happens overnight and is likely to be completed at the main transmitter by 06.00 on the above dates, but some viewers who receive their signals from local relay transmitters, may find that services do not start until later in the day.

Despite a major publicity campaign, some older and disabled people may not be aware of how the switchover will affect them and what they need to do, so please look out for your neighbours and ensure that, **if they are receiving an analogue signal for the Yorkshire TV Region**, they are not left without a TV picture when the time comes. If you, or someone you know, need assistance with conversion to digital equipment then there is a Help Scheme for those over 75 or with a disability – call 0800 40 85 900. If you, or someone you know, need help with retuning, advice is available on 08456 50 50 50.

Viewers who currently receive an analogue signal for **Tyne Tees TV** from the Bilsdale transmitter will switch over from analogue to digital in mid-late 2012.

[How can I tell if I watch an analogue signal from the Yorkshire TV Region? If you can watch Yorkshire Region News and can only access up to five channels (BBC 1, 2, ITV 1, Channel 4 and 5), then you are probably receiving an analogue signal and need to prepare for switchover.]

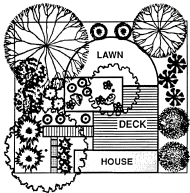

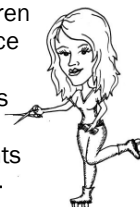
