Following the transformation phase at Ryedale District Council where services have been streamlined and the size of the council reduced in order to make it more efficient. However there are still many challenges that lie ahead;

maintaining key services in the face of reduced funding from Central Government being one of them.

With the recent heavy rainfall that we have been experiencing comes the threat of localised flooding. From what I have seen there has been little in the way of support from Highways Agency and even less from the Environmental Agency. This is an issue that I intend to pursue with the relevant agencies and Ryedale District Council.


St Mary's Wharram le Street Gift Day
