## A View from County Hall



On Monday 22nd June at 9am, we got the call to say that as of that very minute, our Children's Services were under OFSTED inspection. As executive member for Children's Services, this came as quite a kick start to the week! It's sometimes escapes our notice that OFSTED inspect a variety of service areas other than schools. This new inspection framework ILACS (Inspection of Local Authority Children's Services) looks at our children's social services, prevention and the corporate parenting of our four hundred children in care. In the scheme of things it is not a high profile service when you compare it to Highways and the social care for our aging adult population. That said, we are all sadly too aware of Local Authorities that have been subjected to high profile media coverage when the unthinkable happens and things go wrong involving a child.

The idea behind this new inspection is that weight is given to a self assessment of our service provision. The inspectors need to be assured that we know our own strengths and weaknesses, so it's not simply about our arrival at the best position, we also have to be clear about our journey. This is quite a break through because in this economically constrained climate, we have to rethink service delivery however if we always have to stand in the "perfect" OFSTED readiness position, then innovation is stifled.

I am meeting Stacey Bulet our new Ryedale District CEO at the end of this month. Stacey is sharing her new role with the county council under the "Better Together" programme. I will be taking the opportunity to highlight service areas where I think there is a need to be more interactive and the opportunities for our children in care and care leavers is a great place to start.

To end on a good note, The Department for Transport have given us some extra money for highways improvements in rural areas. The resurfacing of the highway at Sked Dale Sherburn and Ganton Hill will be included in this scheme. Of course we all know that there is much more to be done but I am none the less delighted to see improvements within the Wolds area.

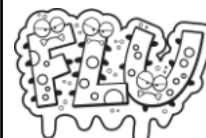
