### **A64 Sherburn to Ganton drainage renewal**

A-one+, working on behalf of Highways England will be starting the second phase of drainage renewal work to improve safety for drivers between Sherburn and Ganton.

#### **What's happening and when?**

The work will involve the renewal of the drainage to the immediate east of Sherburn. It follows phase one that targeted the flooding problems that regularly occurred in Sherburn village near the crossroads and was completed in June.

It is envisaged that work will continue towards Ganton subject to funding being made available in the future.

Work is planned to due to start on Monday 14 September for around 20 weeks and should be completed by the end of January 2021 (weather permitting).

The work will include:

- The wholesale renewal of the existing drainage in the area including drainage pipes and gullies. We are also taking the opportunity to making changes to the position and size of some of the gullies in various locations.

#### **Closures, restrictions and diversions**

Temporary traffic lights will be used between Sherburn and Ganton throughout the work, overnight 8pm to 6am Monday to Friday.

We aim to keep disruption to a minimum and apologise in advance for any disruption you might experience.

## Additional information

As part of our programme of improvements along the A64 we have been installing what are known as village “gateways” in several locations between Welburn and Staxton which includes Sherburn, Ganton and Potter Brompton. For these “gateways” we will be lowering the speed limit, installing additional signing and coloured surfacing. We hope to finish this work by end of December 2020.

In addition we have a planned carriageway reconstruction/resurfacing scheme that will be carried out after the drainage renewal work. Further details will be provided on this as and when the programme and details have been finalised.
